Key Areas of Learning

To develop our Physical skills we will be exploring our outdoor learning space and Forest School areas, finding minibeasts and making delicious meals in our mud kitchen. We will also be learning about how humans change and grow through their lives and thinking about the things we can do now that we could not do when we were babies. We will be reading 'Superhero Me!', 'Supertato' and 'Superworm'.

To develop our Communication and Language skills the children will be learning how to share news with the rest of the class and taking part in whole class conversations, both listening, responding and asking questions.

To develop our Personal, Social and Emotional Skills this term we will be studying the illustrator Roger Hargreaves and trying to emulate some of his Mr. Men characters. We will also be painting our own self portraits.

LITERACY

Comprehension — Demonstrate understanding of stories through verbal retelling, predict key events and use and apply new vocabulary learnt in different contexts.

Word Reading — We will use Letters and Sounds phonic scheme to develop children's phonic knowledge beginning learning new GPCs; develop children's book talk through weekly guided reading sessions; and answer questions about texts, thinking about what might happen next.

Writing — We will make opportunities for mark making inside and out; use our phonic knowledge to sound out cvc words and learn to write our names.
