Key Areas of Learning



Curriculum Overview Year 5

Autumn 1 2023





As **Scientists**, we will be learning about 'Forces'. In this topic, we will carry out investigations into the effects of friction, gravity, air resistance and water resistance as well as exploring mechanisms such as gears, pulleys and levers.

As **Historians**, we will be learning about The Shang Dynasty of Ancient China. We will learn about what life was like during the Shang Dynasty in terms of the social hierarchy and religious beliefs. We will think about the discovery of oracle bones and what we can learn about the past from such artefacts. We will also explore the invention of writing by trying brush lettering.

ENGLISH

In our Reading lessons, we will focus on a range of historical texts. In writing, we will be creating an historical narrative based on WW2, using an animation for inspiration. We will focus on using descriptive language and dialogue to engage the reader as well as ensuring our stories have a clear structure.

MATHEMATICS

We will first be learning about place value with a focus on rounding, roman numerals and negative numbers. We will then move on to addition and subtraction with a focus on written methods before learning about factors, multiples and prime numbers in multiplication and division.

In RE our key question is:

'What does it mean if God is holy

We will also have a visit to St
