



## Summary of SATs Results 2019

We are very proud of the attainment of each of the 31 Year 6 pupils who completed the 2019 KS2 SATs.

The percentages of pupils achieving the expected standard or above in the 2018 Key Stage 2 tests by subject were:

	<b>Moseley</b>	<b>National</b>
Reading	100%	73%
GPS	97%	78%
Writing	92%	78%
Maths	100%	79%
Combined	92%	65%

At Moseley CE, the percentages of children achieving a high standard in the 2018 Key Stage 2 Tests by subject were:

Reading	68%
GPS	55%
Writing	45%
Maths	45%
Combined	32%

Combined figures in this context mean the percentage of children who reached the required standard in all 3 of the assessed areas of reading, writing and maths.

In 2016 the DFE introduced a scaled score of between 80 and 120 which ranks the children's raw score against a national scale of achievement. A 100 score represents the expected standard and above 110 represents a higher standard. Below 100 means that a child is working below the expected standard.

The average scaled score by subject at Moseley CE were:

	<b>Moseley</b>	<b>National</b>
Reading	112	104
GPS	111	106
Maths	110	105

There is no scaled score for writing as this is a teacher assessed judgement.

Progress scores were:

Reading	+3.8
Writing	+0.4
Maths	+1.2

A score of 0 means that progress was made in line with other children from the same starting point (KS1 SATs score) nationally. A positive score shows that progress was accelerated in comparison, and a negative score shows that progress was lower.
