

Re: Creative Arts Week

Dear parents and carers

As you know, our Creative Arts week is the last week of this half term. This will be a celebration of our individual and collective creativity in our school community and will be an artistic exploration of this half term's value of Love.

Each class will showcase our school value of community by thinking about key things that make our community special. We will use the story 'Hey Wall' to give context to this. Resources for this project have been purchased using the money raised by classes during Challenge 22. We are very thankful to the PTA and the children and families whose generosity has funded this exciting project. Every child will create a small canvas that will build a 'wall' showing our Moseley community. Each class will create their canvasses in shades of their class colour (e.g. courage class is orange) and we will build these together to create a wonderful art installation.

Each year will have a different focus for their art:

- Year R** – friends in our class
- Year 1** – important people in school
- Year 2** – special buildings in our community
- Year 3** – seasons in our community
- Year 4** – special people in our local community
- Year 5** - special events in our community
- Year 6** – Moseley as part of our wider community.

During the week will also be using our forest school space to create collaborative, natural artwork inspired by the artist James Brunt.

Throughout the week, the whole school will be taking part in a Greenpeace and National Poetry Day activity. We will be learning to perform a Benjamin Zephaniah poem: Nature Trail. We will use his wonderful poem to inspire us to create our own 'Poems for our Planet'.

Our school community will be learning to perform 2 songs SingUp! Let Love Shine Through, and We Shall Go Out with Joy.

We love opportunities to share our creativity and learning with our families and so we would like to invite our families to join us on the KS1 playground for a short performance on Friday 21st October at 9.10am (after morning drop off) to hear us perform our poetry and songs.
